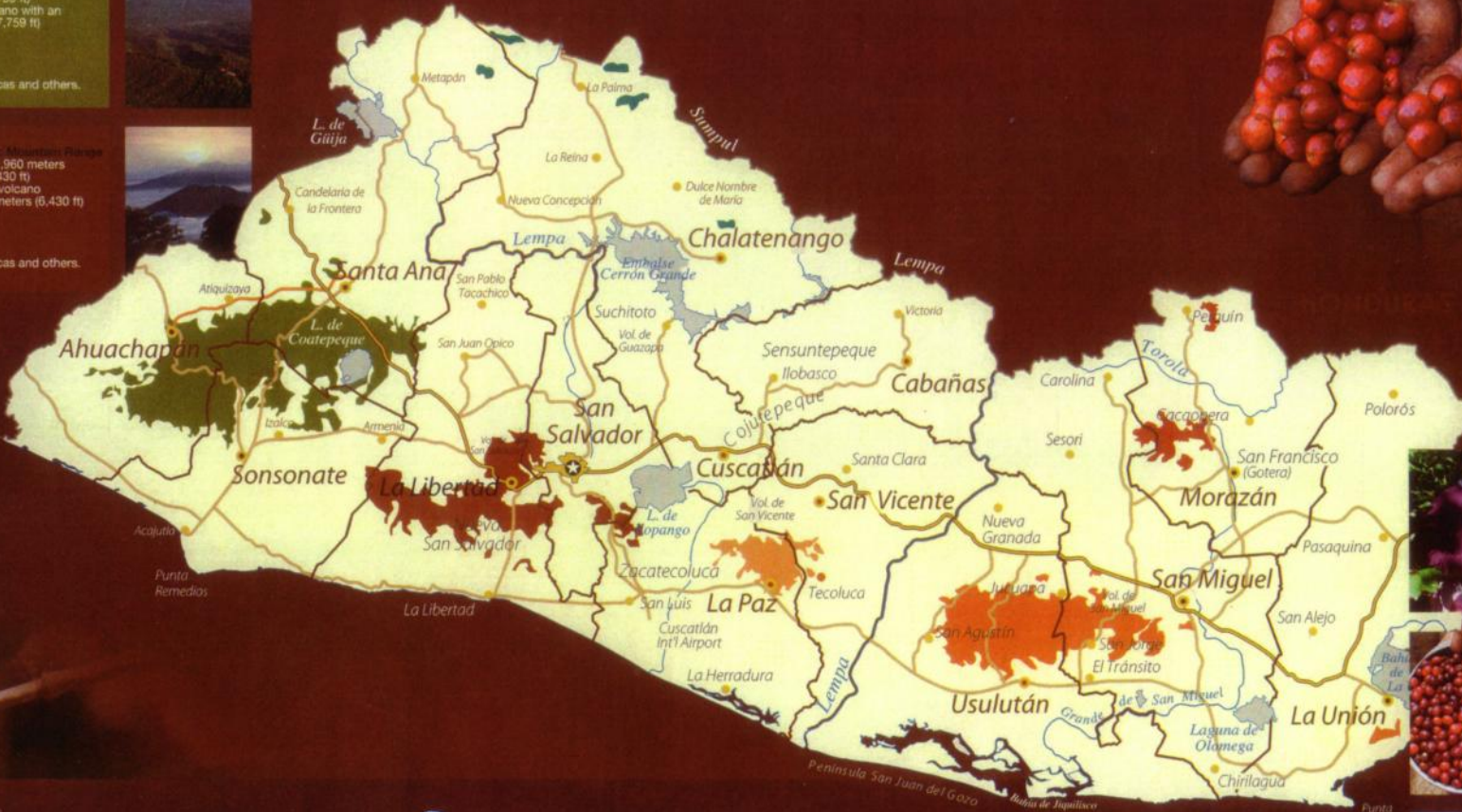
Ananaco – Ilimotepic Mountain Range

El Estero – Quetzaltenango Mountain Range
 Altitude: from 500 to over 1,960 meters above sea level (1,640 – 6,430 ft)
 Main Peak: San Salvador volcano with an elevation of 1,960 meters (6,430 ft)

Chichontepec Mountain Range
 Altitude: from 500 to over 1,630 meters above sea level (1,640 – 5,280 ft)

Chaparrastique Mountain Range

Tecapa – Chinameca Mountain Range

 Main Peaks: San Miguel or Chaparrastique volcano with an elevation of 2,139 meters (7,017 ft)

 69.5% Bourbon
 22.2% Pacas
 8.3% mixed of Bourbon and Pacas

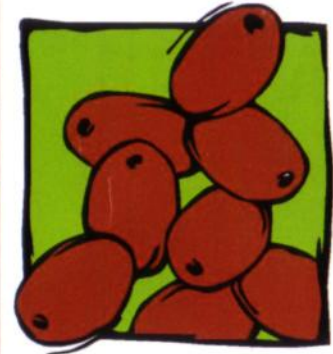

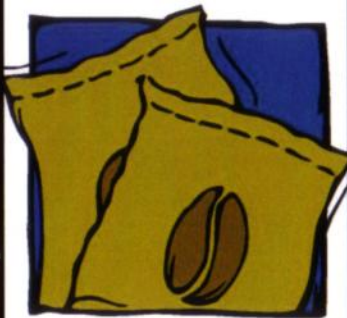
